In North Lanarkshire, we support disabled people (and those who support/ care for them) to learn. Our Learning co-ordinator works with a team of dedicated volunteers to directly support learners with:

- Flexible person-centred, individualised guidance and support
- Gaining new skills and achieving learning goals
- Building self-confidence
- Progressing on to further learning, volunteering or employment

Volunteering

We have many different types of volunteer roles available, including directly supporting learners. We offer our volunteers induction, training, support and out of pocket expenses, and we are proud to hold the “Investing in Volunteers” award.

Our information service offers free advice by phone or e-mail to disabled people and those who support/care for them across Scotland. We can provide information and advice on a wide range of issues relating to post-16 learning and disability, as well as a range of free information materials and newsletters.
